

LIST OF DOCUMENTS THAT CONFIRM KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH AT A LEVEL NOT LOWER THAN B2

1. A certificate, diploma, or other document confirming knowledge of a given foreign language in the four language skills: listening comprehension, reading, speaking, and writing, at a proficiency level of B2, C1, or C2, issued by one of the following institutions:

1.1. University of Cambridge, ESOL Examinations:

- 1.1.1. B2 First (FCE),
- 1.1.2. C1 Advanced (CAE),
- 1.1.3. C2 Proficiency (CPE),
- 1.1.4. B2 Business Vantage (BEC Vantage),

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) – minimum score of 5.5,

- 1.6.2. LanguageCert Academic – LanguageCert Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International (Listening, Reading, Writing, Speaking) (LanguageCert Academic B2) or higher,

2. A certificate of completion (at institutions accredited by the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange-NAWA) of a preparatory course for undertake higher education as referred to in Article 60(4) of the Act of 12 December 2013 on Foreigners, lasting no less than 9 months, certifying knowledge of a given foreign language in the four language skills: Listening, Reading, Speaking and Writing, at language proficiency level B2, C1 or C2;

3. A diploma of completion of first-cycle (Bachelor's), second-cycle (Master's), or long-cycle Master's degree studies in philology in the field of the given foreign language or applied linguistics, issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or a foreign university, together with a diploma supplement or certificate confirming that the number of class hours in that foreign language amounted to at least 500 hours;

4. A diploma of completion of first-cycle, second-cycle, or long-cycle Master's degree studies issued by a higher education institution operating within the higher education and science system of the Republic of Poland or a foreign university, containing information about the language of instruction; in cases where the diploma does not include such information – a diploma supplement or a certificate providing information about the language of instruction of the studies is additionally required;

5. The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, in relation to the main language;

6. The European Baccalaureate (EB) Diploma, in relation to the first (L1) or second (L2) language;

7. A certificate of entitlement to practice as a sworn translator of a given foreign language, issued by the Minister of Justice, as referred to in Article 5(2) of the Act of 25 November 2004 on the Profession of Sworn Translator, or a certificate confirming entry into the register of sworn translators of the given foreign language.
